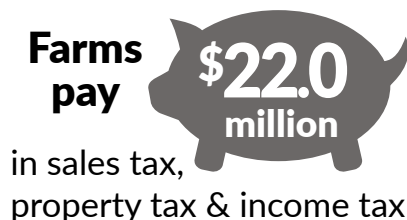

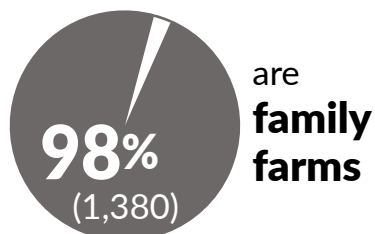

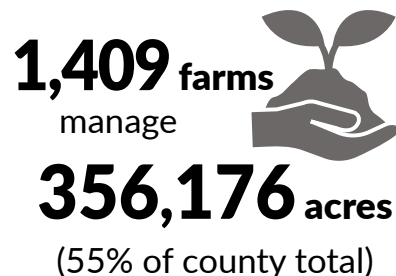

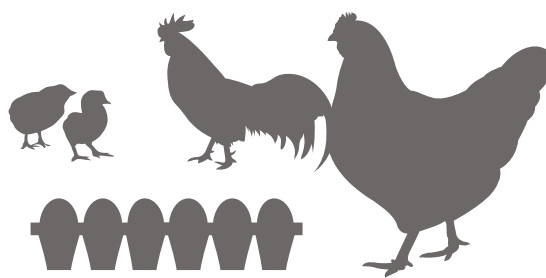
THE AGRICULTURE SECTOR BENEFITS THE ENTIRE COUNTY

Forage production of alfalfa, hay, and corn silage provides a solid feed base for the dairy and cattle industry. The county ranks high in goat and poultry production.
