On weekends our towns come alive with farmers markets and live music. A great chance to unwind and meet the locals, or test drive a new community. Drive time from Platteville is indicated.

Mitchell-Rountree Stone Cottage, 260 W. Madison St., Platteville (5 minutes): 10AM - 4PM

The 1838 cottage is the oldest house in Platteville and on the National Register of Historic Places. See furnishings, clothing, books, and personal objects of the Mitchell and Rountree families dating from the 1820s through the 1950s. Special Friday Tours could be booked via Nancy at 608 778-1535.

Iowa County Dairy Breakfast, 623 Old State Rd. 80, rural Muscoda (45 mins): 6:30AM - 10:30AM

In the heart of dairy country, we celebrate milk on a grand scale. Each county here celebrates with an annual dairy breakfast attracting thousands of people. This year the Putz family will be hosts and invite you to Level Acres Dairy Farm, located between Avoca and Muscoda – look for signs.

Crawford County Dairy Breakfast, WI-131 near Opals Ln., rural Gays Mills (1 hour): 6:00AM - 10:00AM

Celebrate dairy at the Crawford County Fairgrounds. See the agricultural community of Crawford County come together around this HUGE breakfast. Activities for the kids and pancakes for everyone!

Montfort "Big Days," Montfort (25 mins): Friday - Sunday

Small town celebration and home of local popcorn grower – Rural Route Popcorn! Three Day Celebration featuring live music, BBQ contest, run/walk event, grilled chicken stand, beer tent, pie stand, a baseball skills contest, and parade on Sunday. What else could you want?

Shullsburg Car Show, Shullsburg (25 mins): 3:00PM – 8:00PM

Over one hundred cars fill one of the regions oldest and most intact downtowns. Food, games, drinks, and fun for all ages. See 150 cars of all types in a very festive atmosphere. You won't believe this county has more cows than people. Located on historic Water Street downtown Shullsburg.

Mineral Point Tour of Homes, 145 High St., Mineral Point (25 mins): 10:00 AM – 4:00 PM

Self-guided tours offer an opportunity to explore a curated selection of homes at your own pace. Volunteers provide insights and answer any questions. This is a rare opportunity to take a peek inside some of Mineral Point's most interesting homes in one of Wisconsin's oldest communities.

"Pickers" Antique and Flea Market, 2600 10th St, Monroe (1 hour): 8:00AM – 5:00PM (Saturday and Sunday)

12th annual year. Located at the Green County Fairgrounds with hundreds of vendors both inside and out. Antiques, vintage, repurposed, collectibles. \$2 admission with proceeds to support youth activities. Saturday 8 - 5 and Sunday 8 - 3.

Community Fish Boil, WI 130, Lone Rock, WI, rural Bear Valley (1 hour): 4:00PM – 8:00PM

Head to Kaul Community Park just outside of Bear Valley for the "world famous" annual Fish Boil with live music and more. Over 700 served in 2023! \$15 per person, \$7.00 for children 12 years of age and under. Located in an historic rural park.
