

# FCC Timeline

- The owner has 10 business days after receipt of a pole attachment application in which to determine whether the application is complete and notify the attacher of that decision.
- If the owner notifies the attacher that the application is not complete within the 10 business day review period, then the owner must specify where and how the application is deficient.
- If there is no response by the owner within 10 business days, or if the owner rejects the application as incomplete but fails to specify any deficiencies in the application, then the application is deemed complete.
- If the owner timely notifies the attacher that the application is incomplete and specifies the deficiencies, a resubmitted application need only supplement the previous application by addressing the issues identified by the utility, and the application shall be deemed complete within five business days after its resubmission, unless the utility specifies which deficiencies were not addressed and how the resubmitted application did not sufficiently address the utility's reasons.
- The attacher may follow this resubmission procedure as many times as it chooses, as long as in each case it makes a bona fide attempt to correct the issues identified by the owner, and in each case the deadlines set forth herein apply to the owners review.
